Many designers have a project or client that ushers them into the next phase of their career. For Brooklyn-based **Alexis Brown** it was her neighbor and friend, the fashion designer Ulla Johnson. Brown, who grew up in DC and got her master's in interior design at Pratt, had been working in the office of AD100 titan Peter Marino for more than a decade when she began designing Johnson's stores and, soon, her homes (*AD*, September 2019 and July/August 2022). She officially launched her own firm in 2017, focusing on residential projects—there's a contemporary Palm Beach family home in the works—as well as commercial ones, like the flagship LA store she is designing for fashion brand Cult Gaia. In every interior, Brown aims to mix in fine art and handmade, artisanal elements to create, in her words, “a sophisticated aesthetic that appeals to both the head and the heart of those who experience the spaces.” alexisbrowninteriordesign.com —HANNAH MARTIN

Where others have zigged, **Andre Mellone** has zagged. In recent years, as professional peers have thrilled to maximalist fervor, punchy patterns, and Memphis nostalgia, the Brazilian-born designer has chosen the path of understated refinement. “Every project starts with simplicity and common sense,” reflects Mellone, who launched his Manhattan-based firm in 2012. “We can create the most intricate and layered interiors starting there.” Spanning residential, retail, and hospitality projects—among them Carolina Herrera’s New York flagship and a new lobby for 50 Rockefeller Plaza—his work foregrounds subtlety and sophistication through texture, materiality, and precision of form. (Current projects range from a Madison Avenue boutique to a ground-up house in Florida.) “Design is as much about emotion as it is about style and look,” says Mellone, whose formidable pedigree includes stints at Robert A.M. When **Young Huh** met an interior designer at a cocktail party in 2001, it was an aha moment for the Fordham University School of Law grad who knew, deep down, she didn't want to be a lawyer. She enrolled in Parsons School of Design and established her own New York-based firm in 2007. Today her projects range from a historic Tudor in Illinois to a 19th-century country house in Dutchess County, New York, and a resort in Turks and Caicos. Her forthcoming product lines include tile for AKDO, hardware for Modern Matter, and wall coverings for Fromental. The common thread is a look that tempers classic references with contemporary finesse. Case in point: her blockbuster 2019 artist's loft for the Kips Bay Decorator Show House, where she mixed French antiques and classical busts with a bold, Cubist-inspired wallpaper. "I'm obsessed with the idea of keeping what is old and making it work today," says the designer. "It's important to respect history but to always innovate."



Neal Beckstedt Studio NEW YORK

It was his family's gut renovation of their Ohio farmhouse that ignited **Neal Beckstedt's** fire for design at the tender age of seven. "Since then I've been drawing floor plans," says the New York-based talent, who went on to study architecture at Ball State University and cut his teeth in Miami with architecture firm Arquitectonica and in New York with John Keenen and Terence Riley. After honing his skills for a decade in the office of designer S. Russell Groves, Beckstedt launched his own firm in 2010 with a major project—the residence of fashion designer Derek Lam (*AD*, September 2015). Business has been booming ever since for the designer, whose knack for laid-back luxury has garnered a serious following (IRL and on Instagram). These days, he's bringing timeworn materials and rustic charm to residential spaces that include an oceanfront barn in Sagaponack, a West Chelsea loft clad in Douglas fir, a stone manor in Cold Spring, and a 1920s Tudor in Connecticut. His words for the easy-breezy look his clients love: "warm modernism focusing on a relaxed luxury." nbeckstedtstudio.com —H.M.

Hadley Wiggins's artistry with pattern, color, and material has long been whispered among the cognoscenti of Long Island's North Fork, where the intrepid interior designer has plied her trade since establishing her namesake firm in 2012. That well-earned reputation exploded on the international scene with the publication of an astonishing home that she orchestrated for an art-world potentate with dazzlingly idiosyncratic tastes (*AD*, December 2021). It was the kind of project that set tongues wagging, but for all its eye-popping drama, the house represented only one facet of the young designer's approach, which privileges the unique requirements of context and client over strained exercises in style with a capital S. The full scope of the designer's talents—including her mastery of quiet, elegant charm—emerges in the broad array of Wiggins's recently completed projects, from sensitive renovations of historic homes in Connecticut to New York City residences that broker a nuanced rapprochement between the classic and the contemporary. hadleywiggins.com —MAYER RUS

Although his interiors are chockablock with joyful eruptions of color, pattern, and whimsy, **Jean-Philippe Demeyer** never strives for purely theatrical effect—there’s a method to his seductive madness. “My ideas come from gut feelings—first about genius loci, then about architectural structure. From there I can start layering and storytelling,” says the Belgian talent, who oversees his Bruges-based practice alongside his two business/domestic partners, Frank Ver Elst and Jean-Paul Dewever. (The trio’s Portuguese getaway was published in *AD*’s June 2022 issue.) Fearlessly blending bold fabrics, outré decorative flourishes, and idiosyncratic artworks with eclectic furnishings, both contemporary and traditional, Demeyer conjures magical environments alive with unapologetic beauty and delight. He applies this winning formula to residential and commercial projects, including popular restaurants and clubs in Paris, Lisbon, Lille, and Ghent. His signature sensibility also finds expression in a wide range of product designs—a sunburst carpet for Codimat Collection, accessories for Svenskt Tenn, a seating collection for Collett & Victor, and, new for 2023, a namesake fabric line and a website for couture pillow creations. jpdemeyer.com —M.R.

SO-IL BROOKLYN

Founded by husband-and-wife team **Florian Idenburg** and **Jing Liu**, this Brooklyn studio has paved the way for a new generation of architects, challenging the status quo in enigmatic buildings of all kinds. In Brooklyn, their design for the Amant arts complex combines textured expanses of brick, concrete, and aluminum into a dynamic sequence of spaces. A Long Island house assembles gabled volumes into a poetic cruciform layout. And their transformation of Site Verrier de Meisenthal, a historic studio-glass center of France, unites three neighboring institutions with an undulating addition that frames a public plaza. “We are both locally rooted and nationless,” they reflect of their wide reach and diverse team, whose origins imbue SO-IL projects with “global narratives and perspectives.” At the core of their practice, however, is commitment to designing for the greater good. “We explore how the creation of environments and objects inspires lasting positive intellectual and societal engagement.” so-il.org-s.c.

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Halard-Halard Design BROOKLYN AND THE COTSWOLDS

As design pedigrees go, **Bastien Halard's** is tough to beat. The French-born founder of Halard-Halard Design is the son of decorator Florence Chabrières, the grandson of interior designers Yves and Michelle Halard, and the great-grandson of Adolphe Halard, founder of the venerable French fabric and wallpaper house Nobilis. He's also the nephew of esteemed interiors photographer François Halard and the husband of landscape designer Miranda Brooks, a fellow AD100 honoree. But all those august relations notwithstanding, Halard has carved out his own place in the broad cosmography of design, gaining acclaim on both sides of the Atlantic for an approach that, in his words, "emphasizes the harmony between classical language and contemporary sensibilities."
